BOOKING CONDITIONS

Bookings are provisional until confirmation from the Museum team has been received.

1. To ensure our visitors have the best possible experience we request that any group of 10 or more people pre-book their visit at least one month in advance.
2. Our rooms are quite small, so we request that large groups split into smaller groups of up to 15 people, with a 15-minute interval between each group's entry.

3. Standard free entry applies to group visits without a guided tour or talk. Donations are very welcome.
4. Each group going through the Museum must be supervised by a group leader and are under the responsibility of the group leader. We also ask all group members to adhere to any instructions from our staff.
5. The Museum is located in a Grade I listed townhouse in which Samuel Johnson and his family lived in the 1700s. Visitors are asked not to touch the furniture and other items on display. Photography is allowed but not for commercial use. We do not allow the use of tripods, selfie-sticks, or flash photography inside the Museum. We ask that the group respect the privacy of other visitors when taking photographs.
6. Please be aware that the Museum is a Grade I listed building with many steps, and regrettably wheelchair access is not available. We are, however, always willing to give any assistance possible. Please contact us if you wish to discuss access for your group.
7. The Museum does not have parking, but there are many car parks nearby.
