BOOKING CONDITIONS

Bookings are provisional until confirmation from the Museum team has been received.

1. Walking tours last around two hours and the distance is approximately two miles. Groups meet outside the Samuel Johnson Birthplace Museum.
2. Walking tours during opening hours cost £6 per person (£60 minimum charge applied for groups of less than 10 people). 15 is the maximum number of people we can take on a walking tour.

3. Out-of-hours walking tours cost £10 per person (£100 minimum charge applied for groups of less than 10 people). 15 is the maximum number of people we can take on a walking tour.
4. Walking tours must be pre-booked at least one month in advance.
5. We are not able to offer bespoke tours. Our tours are led by our knowledgeable guides. This walking tour explores the areas and landmarks in Lichfield linked to Samuel Johnson.
6. Each group must be supervised by a group leader and are under the responsibility of the group leader. We also ask all group members to adhere to any instructions from our staff.
7. The Museum does not have parking, but there are many car parks nearby.
